All public improvement contracts requiring an expenditure of one two hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) (\$200,000.00) or more shall be handled by the operating departments and shall be made only upon a competitive bid basis after plans and specifications have been prepared, are on file in the operating departments and, upon recommendation of the mayor, have been approved by the city council."

Section 4. That if any part of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of any conflict.

Section 6. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon becoming a law.
