

ORDINANCE NO. 416

AN ORDINANCE
TO AMEND CHAPTER 2 – ADMINISTRATION, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
OF THE CITY OF TROY BY CHANGING THE VOTING PLACE FOR DISTRICT 2
FROM THE TROY ADAMS NATIONAL GUARD ARMORY TO COLLEGEDALE
CHURCH OF CHRIST

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Troy, Alabama, adopted the Code of Ordinances of the City of Troy, November 24, 1987, as amended, and;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Troy finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the City of Troy and will serve a valid and sufficient public purpose for the voting location for District 2 in the City of Troy to be changed from the Adams National Guard Armory, George Wallace Drive, to Collegedale Church of Christ, 701 Dr. John M. Long Avenue, effective immediately as of the date of the adoption and publication of this ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. It is hereby found and declared by the City Council that it is in the best interest of the City of Troy and will serve a valid and sufficient public purpose for the voting location for District 2 in the City of Troy to be changed from the Adams National Guard Armory, George Wallace Drive, to Collegedale Church of Christ, 701 Dr. John M. Long Avenue, effective immediately as of the date of the adoption and publication of this ordinance and, accordingly, Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Troy, as amended, is hereby amended as follows:


By striking and deleting Section 2-3 of said Chapter 2 and replacing with the following new Section 2-3:

Sec. 2-3. Polling places; hours.


Voting places for each district are hereby designated and established as follows:

5	Pike County Courthouse


