

**ORDINANCE NO. 4727**

**ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF VILLA PARK, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AMENDING ARTICLE I OF CHAPTER 14, MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, OF THE VILLAGE OF VILLA PARK MUNICIPAL CODE**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Villa Park is a duly organized and validly existing non home rule municipality created in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970 and the laws of the State; and

**WHEREAS**, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Villa Park have determined that it is in the best interests of the Village and its citizens to amend the Village of Villa Park Municipal Code to establish designated local truck routes in the Village as more particularly set forth hereinafter.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Villa Park, DuPage County, State of Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1:** That Article I of Chapter 14 of the Village of Villa Park Municipal Code, as previously adopted and subsequently amended, is hereby further amended to add thereto the following:

**"Section 14-121. – Local truck routes.**

(a) The following streets within and under the jurisdiction of the Village are designated as local truck routes:

*Monterey Avenue*, from Fairfield Avenue to Wildwood Avenue

*St. Charles Road*, from Westmore Avenue to Salt Creek

*Villa Avenue*, from Wildwood Avenue to St. Charles Road

*Wildwood Avenue*, from Villa Avenue to Monterey Avenue

(b) It shall be unlawful to operate any vehicle in excess of eight thousand (8,000) pounds on any street within and under the jurisdiction of the Village not designated by Section 14-121(a) as a local truck route.

(c) This section shall not apply to those vehicles which are operated for the purpose of making a delivery or pick up or providing services to a location where direct access by a local truck route is not available, in which case such

vehicle may be operated on a street not designated as a local truck route for not more than the minimum distance necessary for the purpose of making such delivery or pick up or providing services.

**Section 2:** That the Village Manager is hereby directed to instruct the Public Works Department to install the appropriate signage as required by the provisions of this ordinance.

**Section 3:** That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


**Section 4:** That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval according to law.

**Section 5:** Sunset Clause. Unless extended, this Ordinance shall expire on its own terms and shall be of no further force and effect from and after June 15, 2023.
