## **ORDINANCE 0417(A)**

Amending Ordinance 14:82, Unnecessary Noise

## WHEREAS, Ordinance 14:82 currently reads as;

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to make, continue, or cause to be made or continued any excessive, raucous, jarring noise, sound and/or music or unreasonably, sound and/or music which tends to disturb or interfere with the peace and good order of persons within the area of audibility; The City of Eunice Board of Aldermen and Alderwoman add the following to section (a) to read as follows:
- (a)....within the area of audibility; with exception being those public events sponsored by the City of Eunice, to include Mardi Gras Celebration, Experience Louisiana Festival and the Crawfish Etouffee Cookoff, city or school sponsored sporting events or any other event approved in a public meeting of the Eunice Board of Aldermen/women.

## WHEREAS, Ordinance 14:82, section (f) currently reads as;

- (f) It shall be unlawful for any person to yell, shout, hoot, whistle or sing, on the public streets, particularly between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. or at any time or place so as to annoy or disturb the quiet, comfort or repose of persons in any office, or in any dwelling, hotel or other type of residence, or of any person in the vicinity. The City of Eunice Board of Aldermen and Alderwoman add the following phrases to section (f), to read as follows:
- (f) It shall be unlawful for any person to yell, shout, hoot, whistle or sing, <u>or use</u> <u>amplified equipment</u> on the public streets, particularly between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. <u>on Friday and Saturdays and between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.</u>

  <u>Sunday through Thursday</u> or at any time or place so as to annoy or disturb the quiet, comfort or repose of persons in any office, or in any dwelling, hotel or other type of residence, or of any person in the vicinity. <u>An exemption to events/times can only be granted by the Eunice</u>

  <u>Board of Aldermen/women in a public meeting.</u>
