ORDINANCE NO. 21-2215

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAKE JACKSON, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 98 TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO ADD A SCHOOL ZONE ON ANCHUSA FOR BESS BRANNEN ELEMENTARY; PROVIDING THAT ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH SHALL BE REPEALED TO THE EXTENT OF THE CONFLICT ONLY; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND SUSPENDING THE CHARTER RULE REQUIRING TWO READINGS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKE JACKSON, TEXAS:

Section 1: That Section 98-86.2(b)(20) be added to read as follows:

On all of that portion of Anchusa Road that lies between the east side of That Way Street to the west side of Royal Oak Drive, during all day school zone hours, K—6th grade.

Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

Section 3: A violation of this ordinance shall be a Class C misdemeanor and the penalty for violating this ordinance shall be as provided for in Sec. 1-5 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Lake Jackson.

Section 4: If any part or portion of this ordinance shall be invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect or impair any remaining portions or provisions of this ordinance.

Section 5: That the rule requiring ordinances to be read on two separate meetings is hereby suspended and that this ordinance shall be passed and become effective from and after the date of its adoption on its first reading.
