

ORDINANCE NO. 7963

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF LEAVENWORTH, KANSAS, CHAPTER 110 TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES, ARTICLE II LOCAL TRAFFIC REGULATIONS SECTION 110-41 SPEED LIMITS – ENUMERATED GENERALLY AND SECTION 110-46 SCHOOL ZONES BE AMENDED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LEAVENWORTH, KANSAS:

Section 1. That the Code of Ordinance, City of Leavenworth, Kansas, Chapter 110, Traffic and Vehicles, Article II, Local Traffic Regulations, be amended and the sections to read as follows:

Sec. 110-41. - Speed limits—Enumerated generally.

(a) The speed limit on the streets or portions thereof designated in this section shall be as follows:

Second Street, from Choctaw Street to Poplar Street, 25 miles per hour.

Second Street, North, from the alley south of Kickapoo to the alley north of Dakota Street, 20 miles per hour.

Third Avenue, South, from Short Street to Chestnut Street, 20 miles per hour.

Tenth Avenue, from Halderman Street to Marion Street, 20 miles per hour (see section 110-46).

Tenth Avenue, from Spruce Street to Limit Street, 30 miles per hour.

Tenth Avenue, from Limit Street to the south end of the Tenth Avenue-Gatewood Street intersection, 35 miles per hour.

Tenth Avenue, from the south end of the Tenth Avenue-Gatewood Street intersection to Eisenhower Road, 40 miles per hour.

15th Street, from Vilas Street north to Thornton Street, 20 miles per hour.

16th Street, from Vilas Street north to Thornton Street, 20 miles per hour.

16th Street Terrace, from Vilas Street north to the dead end, 20 miles per hour.

17th Street, from Vilas Street north to Thornton Street, 20 miles per hour.

17th Street Terrace, from Thornton Street south to the dead end, 20 miles per hour.

19th Street, south of Thornton Street to its point of termination, 20 miles per hour.

19th Street Terrace, from 20th Street Trafficway to Thornton Street, 20 miles per hour.

20th Street Trafficway, from Spruce Street to Eisenhower Road, 40 miles per hour.

Brookside Street, 20 miles per hour.

Cambridge Street, south from Evergreen Street to its point of termination and south of Thornton Street to its point of termination, 20 miles per hour.

Deerfield Street West, from Shrine Park Road to Garland Avenue, 20 miles per hour.

Eisenhower Road, from Highway 73 to Shrine Park Road, 40 miles per hour.

Evergreen Street, from 19th Street Terrace to 17th Street Terrace, 20 miles per hour.

Evergreen Street, from 17th Street to 17th Street Terrace, 20 miles per hour.

Fawncreek West, from Shrine Park Road to Garland Avenue, 20 miles per hour.

Folsom Street, from Vilas Street north to Santa Fe Street, 20 miles per hour.

Frances Court, 20 miles per hour.

Garland Avenue, from Fawncreek to Village Street, 20 miles per hour.

Gatewood Street, 20 miles per hour.

Grand Avenue, from Halderman Street to Marion Street, 20 miles per hour.

Grand Street, from Halderman Street to Spruce Street, 20 miles per hour.

Halderman Street, from Tenth Avenue to Westwood, 20 miles per hour.

Hughes Road, from Eisenhower to Muncie Road, 35 mph.

Jeanne Court, 20 miles per hour.

Kingman, from Marion Street to Sherman Street, 20 miles per hour.

Klemp Street, from Kansas Street to Quincy Street, 20 miles per hour.

Klemp Street, from Ohio Street to Halderman Street, 20 miles per hour.

Lawrence Avenue, from Thornton Street to Halderman Street, 20 miles per hour.

Marion Street, from 16th Street to Sunset Court, 20 miles per hour.

Marion Street, from 17th Street Terrace east to 17th Street, 20 miles per hour.

Marion Street, from Grand Avenue to Tenth Avenue, 20 miles per hour.

Martin Luther King Drive and Ralph Bunche Drive, (the interior streets of Valley View Apartments), 20 miles per hour.

Muncie Road, from Shrine Park Road to Hughes Road, 20 miles per hour.

Osage Street, from 12th Street to 14th Street, 30 miles per hour.

Parkway Drive South, from Village Street to Muncie Road, 20 miles per hour.

Pin Oak Street, 20 miles per hour.

Santa Fe Street, from 16th Street to 15th Street, 20 miles per hour.

Santa Fe Trail, from Metropolitan Street traveling north to the City limits, 40 miles per hour.

Shawnee Street, from Tenth Street east to Broadway Street, 30 miles per hour.

Shawnee Street, from 12th Street to 14th Street, 30 miles per hour.

Sunset Court, 20 miles per hour.

Thornton Street, from 16th Street to 15th Street, 20 miles per hour.

Thornton Street, from 18th Street to 17th Street, 20 miles per hour.

Tonganoxie Road, from 14th Street to 20th Street, 35 miles per hour.

Village Street West, from Garland Avenue to Parkway Drive, 20 miles per hour.

Washington Street, between Spruce Street and Ohio Street, 20 miles per hour.

Westwood Street, from Halderman to Ohio Street including Forrest Lane, 20 miles per hour.

- (b) Any person, upon conviction of a violation of this section, shall be fined as provided in the penalty section of the Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities as adopted by Section 110-1

Sec. 110-46 School Zones

- (a) The following streets and portions of streets are hereby designated as school zones:

Anthony School.

2nd Avenue between Evergreen Street to Thornton Street as a school zone.

4th Avenue between Evergreen Street to Thornton Street as a school zone.

Thornton Street between 2nd Avenue to 4th Avenue as a school zone.

Evergreen Street between 2nd Avenue to 4th Avenue as a school zone.

David Brewer School. Ottawa Street 150 feet east of 17th Street to 19th Street as a school zone.

18th Street between Ottawa Street to Miami Street as a school zone.

17th Street between Ottawa Street to Miami Street as a school zone.

Henry Leavenworth Elementary School.

20th Street north and south of Vilas Street as a school zone.

Lawson Elementary School.

5th Street between Kiowa and Pawnee Street as a school zone.

Leavenworth High School.

10th Avenue between Marion Street and Halderman Street as a school zone.

Muncie School.

Muncie Road between Hughes Road to Lakeview Drive as a school zone.

Hughes Road 150 feet north and 150 feet south of its intersection with Muncie Road as a school zone.

St. Paul Lutheran Elementary School and Xavier Upper Schools.

7th Street between Miami to Pottawatomie Street as a school zone.

Warren Middle School.

New Lawrence Road from 100 feet south of Gatewood Street to 200 feet south of Wildwood Road as a school zone.

West Middle School.

Spruce Street from 18th Street to 20th Street as a school zone.

Xavier Pre-school.

2nd Avenue between Prospect Street to Ohio Street.

(b) All school zones are in effect when schools are in session and during the hours posted on school zoning signage.

(c) All school zones shall be clearly marked with static signage or electronic signage that indicates the beginning of and the end of a school zone as required by Manual of Uniformed Traffic Control Devices.

Section 2. That the signs required by these sections shall be erected as required by City Ordinance.


Section 3. That the provisions of this Ordinance shall take effect upon posting of the appropriate signs.
