

ORDINANCE NO. 3570

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MIDWEST CITY MUNICIPAL CODE, CHAPTER 2, ADMINISTRATION; ARTICLE VIII, PURCHASING; SECTION 2-118, BIDS REQUIRED; INVITATION; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER AND SEVERABILITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIDWEST CITY, OKLAHOMA:

**ORDINANCE**

**Section 1.** That the Midwest City Municipal Code, Chapter 2 Administration; Article VIII, Purchasing; Section 2-118, Bids required; invitation; is hereby amended to read as follows:

**Section 2-118. Bids required; invitation**

Every city contract for purchase of supplies, materials or equipment exceeding one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) shall be purchased from the lowest and best bidder after due notice inviting bids by this city or any other political subdivision in the state with similar or more stringent bidding requirements, or the city may avail itself of the provisions of the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Office or use a purchasing cooperative pursuant to the requirements of the Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974 as its agent for the purchase or procurement of any item provided under the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act or the Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974. If this city chooses to solicit bids and provides such notice, that notice shall be published in an official newspaper in the city at least ten (10) days prior to the date set for the receipt of the bids.

**Section 2.** REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**Section 3.** SEVERABILITY. If any section, sentence, clause, or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of the ordinance.
