AN ORDINANCE of the CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS

Amending Title 2, Chapter 20 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances relating to Administration: Personnel.

The City Council of The City of Minneapolis do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following classifications in Section 20.10.01 of the above entitled ordinance be amended to make the following changes effective January 1, 1993:

20.10.01 Council Jurisdiction.

The compensation of the listed classifications under City Council jurisdiction shall be provided in this Chapter.

The rates of pay herein provided shall be effective as of January 1, 1993, and July 1, 1993, except as hereinafter provided, and shall apply to all persons in the employ of the City on or after the enumerated effective date, including those who have since such date retired or have been laid off through no fault or delinquency of such employee, but shall not apply to any employee heretofore separated from the service by voluntary resignation or through fault or delinquency on the part of such employee.

The rates stated herein shall be the bi-weekly salary rates unless stated otherwise.

In the event of a midweek holiday or holidays the on call Technician shall be paid an additional hour of one and one-half times their hourly rate for each holiday.

Effective January 1, 1993, add \$.06 cents per hour for all permanent employees hired prior to October 15, 1992 until they complete nine years of service.

Provided that a \$.25 cents per hour shift differential be paid for shifts which start between the hours of 12:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.






