Ordinance Number 1206

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THOMASTON, GEORGIA, TO AMEND SECTIONS 82-26 OF CHAPTER 82 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF THOMASTON, RELATIVE TO CERTAIN SANITARY TAX; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING CODE SECTIONS; TO SET AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND LIKE PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Thomaston, Georgia, and it is hereby ordained by virtue of the authority thereof, as follows:

SECTION 1

The Code of the City of Thomaston, Georgia, Section 82-26, be and it hereby is, amended to read as follows:


Sec. 82-26. Levied — Family dwelling unit.

“There is hereby levied and assessed a monthly sanitary tax of \$20.00 against each residential unit within the corporate limits of the city for the collection and removal of disposable matter permitted by this Code to be placed on the curb or adjacent to back alleys, and for the collection and disposal of garbage and rubbish required by this Code to be stored in a proper container; an additional \$13.75 fee will be added for each additional container; and where any building contains therein more than one family unit or apartment, then the tax is hereby levied separately for each such family dwelling unit or apartment unless said building is identified by city records as being associated with a commercial dumpster account; and where any building contains therein more than one family unit or apartment and is identified by city records as being associated with a commercial dumpster account, an additional sanitary tax of \$7.00 is hereby levied separately against each such family dwelling unit or apartment. Additional costs may be assessed as set forth in Sec. 70-29(3) for yard waste. The city shall not provide sanitation services to any consumer who has an outstanding unpaid indebtedness to the city for previously provided sanitation services until such time as such unpaid indebtedness is fully paid and satisfied.”

SECTION 2


The rates and charges fixed and established in this Ordinance shall become effective for sanitary services provided on **May 1, 2024**, and thereafter.
