ORDINANCE NO. 2020-382

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 28-624 IN CHAPTER 28-ZONING OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WACO, TEXAS, TO ALLOW AUTOMOBILE SERVICING ESTABLISHMENTS AS A SPECIAL USE IN THE C-2 COMMUNITY COMMERCIAL ZONING DISTRICT; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF **ORDINANCES** IN CONFLICT **HEREWITH:** PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE PROVIDING **PENALTIES:** AND CODE: FOR FINDING AND DETERMINING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS ORDINANCE IS PASSED IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WACO, TEXAS:

Section 1. That Section 28-624 of Chapter 28 - Zoning of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Waco, Texas, shall be amended and shall read as follows (<u>deletions</u>/<u>additions</u>):

Sec. 28-624. Special uses.

(26) Automobile servicing establishments including: the retail dispensing or servicing of vehicle fuels, lubricants, tires and vehicle accessories; the minor repair or replacement of parts, tires, paintless dent repair, and performing state inspections and making minor repairs necessary to pass state inspection for personal and light commercial vehicles. All work shall be within an enclosed structure.

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That the terms and provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed to be severable and that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance shall be declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance and the remainder of such ordinance

shall continue in full force and effect the same as if such invalid or unconstitutional provision had never been a part hereof.

Section 4. That it is the intention of the City Council and is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance shall become and be a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Waco, Texas, and that sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention.

Section 5. That a violation of this ordinance shall be a Class C misdemeanor and the penalty for violating this ordinance shall be as provided for in Sec. 1-14 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Waco, Texas, which shall be a fine of not less than \$1.00 and no more than \$2,000.00, and each day a violation exists shall be a separate offense.

Section 6. That it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance is passed is open to the public and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.
