

ORDINANCE NO. 3780

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF CLINTON, MISSOURI AMENDING CHAPTER 7, ARTICLE 2 OF THE CLINTON MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING ENGLEWOOD CEMETERY.

WHEREAS the Englewood Cemetery Board of Trustees has the authority to make recommendations to the Clinton City Council regarding Englewood Cemetery; and

WHEREAS the Clinton City Council has the authority to amend City Codes regarding Englewood Cemetery;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CLINTON CITY COUNCIL AMENDS CHAPTER 7, ARTICLE 2 AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Sec. 7-26 is hereby enacted as follows:

Sec. 7-26. Grave lots.

Burials in grave lots shall be limited to:

- (a) one (1) casket per grave lot,
- (b) the cremains of two (2) individuals, per grave lot,
- (c) one (1) casket and the cremains of one (1) individual, which shall be placed within the casket, per grave lot.

Sec. 7-30. Cremains is hereby repealed and re-enacted as follows:

- (a) All cremains to be buried in Englewood Cemetery shall be placed in a burial vault made of a suitable material, as approved by the Cemetery Board.
- (b) Any disposition of cremains shall require a permit and fee. This shall include, but is not limited to, scattering, placement within a monument, and placement within a casket.
- (c) An acceptable form of indelible identification shall be placed with cremains interred in Englewood Cemetery. This shall not apply to scattered cremains.

Sec. 7-31. Columbarium

Sec. 7-31(c) is hereby repealed and Sec. 7-31 (c), (d), and (e) are enacted as follows:

- (c) Each niche shall be limited to the cremains of one (1) individual.
- (d) Each niche shall have its own, separate faceplate.
- (e) Faceplates shall be limited to:
 - 1. name, date of birth and date of death, in an approved font that is no smaller than one inch (1") in height,
 - 2. no more than four (4) emblems, each no larger than one and five-eighths inch (1 5/8").

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval as provided by law.

Section 3. Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
