

ORDINANCE NO. 3880

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF CLINTON, MISSOURI AMENDING CHAPTER 5 OF THE CLINTON MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING ANIMALS.

WHEREAS the Public Safety Committee comprised of City Council members has reviewed Chapter 5 of the Clinton Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS that same committee has made recommendations regarding changes to Chapter 5 of the Clinton Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS the Clinton City Council has the authority to amend the Clinton Municipal Code;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CLINTON CITY COUNCIL HEREBY AMENDS CHAPTER 5, SECTION 5-37(b) (5) AND SECTION 5-39(d) TO READ AS FOLLOWS AND HEREBY REPEALS SECTION 5-42:

ARTICLE III. - DOGS AND CATS

Sec. 5-37. - Dangerous dogs or cats.

(b)(5) Any dog or cat which, while on the owner's property, has bitten a human being other than the owner or a member of the owner's family who is under the age of 14 and normally resides at the place where the dog or cat is kept.

Sec. 5-39. - Impoundment; release; fees.

(d) The owner of any dog or cat so impounded may redeem the animal upon payment of a ten-dollar (\$10.00) impoundment fee and a boarding fee of fifteen-dollars (\$15.00) per day, and the payment of any veterinarian fees for treatment and/or rabies vaccination.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval as provided by law.

Read the first time this 5th day of August, 2014.

Read a second time and passed this 2nd day of September, 2014.
