AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ON-CALL CONTRACTS WITH ENGINEERING CONSULTANTS FOR A 3-YEAR PERIOD

WHEREAS, the City desires to have qualified engineering consultants pre-selected for future contracts on an on-call basis for three years (2024-2026) without the need to solicit qualifications for engineering or other professional services on an individual project basis; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-324 of the Municipal Code provides that in accordance with Missouri State Law professional services contracts shall be awarded following a Request for Qualifications process in which firms are invited to submit their qualifications for desired engineering services and firms are then selected solely on the basis of those qualifications with contract pricing negotiated on a project basis; and

WHEREAS, upon request for qualifications from thirty-one (31) firms on October 17, 2023, twenty (20) consultants responded by the November 17th deadline with submittals in any of seven (7) areas of expertise, generating a total of fifty-seven (57) submittals; and

SECTION FOUR: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Board of Aldermen.
