ORDINANCE NO. 25-03

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF DENHAM SPRINGS, CHAPTER 10 BY ADDING SECTION 94-7 RELATIVE TO APPEALS TO THE CITY COUNCIL

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Denham Springs, Louisiana, in regular public session convened that:

Section 94-7 be added as follows:

Section 94-7 Appeal to City Council

- (a) Any applicant whose proposal is rejected in whole or in part by Planning Commission may appeal to the City Council within six months of the meeting at which the proposal was heard and action was taken. The appeal must be in writing and fully state the reason or reasons for appeal. A copy of the proposed plan, as submitted to the Commission, must also accompany the written appeal.
- (b) A decision of the City Council to modify or reverse a decision of the Planning Commission shall be in writing in the minutes of the meeting, and shall set forth the reasons therefore. The decision shall also specify the conditions upon which the modification is made.

Said Ordinance having been introduced on the 11th day of March, 2025 by Lori Lamm-Williams, notice of Public Hearing having been published on the 27th day of March, 2025, said Public Hearing having been held, title having been read and Ordinance considered, on motion by Lamm-Williams, seconded by Gilbert to adopt the Ordinance, a record vote was taken and the following result was had:
