## **ORDINANCE RZ-2024-01**

1	AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF
2	FOREST PARK, GEORGIA BY REZONING THAT CERTAIN PARCEL OF REAL
3	PROPERTY LOCATED AT 0 FERGUSON COURT; TO PROVIDE FOR
4	SEVERABILITY; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE AN
5	EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR ALL OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.
6	WHEREAS, the duly elected governing authority of the City of Forest Park,
7	Georgia (hereinafter the "City") is the Mayor and Council thereof; and
8	WHEREAS, the governing authority is authorized by its Charter to regulate zoning
9	within the limits of the City; and
10	WHEREAS, the subject parcel of real property consists of approximately 0.16 acres
11	located at 0 Ferguson Court, according to the present system of numbering property in
11 12	Forest Park, Clayton County, Georgia (Tax Parcel Identification Number: 13049A A031)

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City has considered the criteria of a rezoning
request, provided in Section 8-8-186 (Zoning Amendment Process) of Article G (Zoning
Amendments) in Chapter 8 (Zoning) of the Code of Ordinances, City of Forest Park,
Georgia; and

WHEREAS, the City has complied with the notice and hearing requirements
pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 36-66-1 *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City will be
positively impacted by the adoption of this Ordinance.

28 BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF

29 THE CITY OF FOREST PARK, GEORGIA, and by the authority thereof:

30 **Section 1.** That certain parcel of real property consisting of approximately 0.16 acres located at 0 Ferguson Court, according to the present system of numbering property 31 in Forest Park, Clayton County, Georgia (Tax Parcel Identification Number: 13049A A031) 32 33 is hereby rezoned to RM (Multiple Family Residential). Such rezoning is to be noted on the official City of Forest Park Zoning Map approved by Mayor and Council ("Zoning Map"), 34 as soon as reasonably possible following adoption of this Ordinance along with an editorial 35 36 note on the map specifying the parcel affected by this Ordinance and the date of its adoption. Until this rezoning is indicated on the Zoning Map, this Ordinance shall govern to the extent 37 38 of any discrepancy between this Ordinance and the Zoning Map. This rezoning is subject to the following conditions: 39

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41 42 The Applicant shall comply with the Multiple Family Residential District Standards in Section 8-8-33. If Applicant desires to proceed with its submitted site plan, Applicant shall:

43	• Apply for a variance to reduce the side yard setback from the
44	required 25 feet to 10 feet;
45	• Apply for a variance to reduce the rear yard setback from the
46	required 35 feet to 30 feet; and
47	• Provide parking capacity for two (2) vehicles per residential unit.
48	2. Applicant shall submit its plans for landscaping and exterior architectural
49	design of the building façade to the Urban Design and Review Board for
50	consideration and approval.
51	3. Any changes or deviations from the approved plans shall be submitted to
52	the Planning Commission for approval.
53	4. The above-mentioned conditions shall be satisfied prior to the issuance of
54	a building permit.
55	Section 2. The preamble of this Ordinance shall be considered to be and is hereby
56	incorporated by reference as if fully set out herein.
57	Section 3. (a) It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Mayor and Council that
58	all sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are or were, upon
59	their enactment, believed by the Mayor and Council to be fully valid, enforceable and
60	constitutional.
61	(b) It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Mayor and Council that, to the
62	greatest extent allowed by law, each and every section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase
63	of this Ordinance is severable from every other section, paragraph, sentence, clause or
64	phrase of this Ordinance. It is hereby further declared to be the intention of the Mayor and
65	Council that, to the greatest extent allowed by law, no section, paragraph, sentence, clause

or phrase of this Ordinance is mutually dependent upon any other section, paragraph,sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

(c) In the event that any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this 68 Ordinance shall, for any reason whatsoever, be declared invalid, unconstitutional or 69 otherwise unenforceable by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent 70 jurisdiction, it is the express intent of the Mayor and Council that such invalidity, 71 72 unconstitutionality or unenforceability shall, to the greatest extent allowed by law, not 73 render invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of the Ordinance and that, to the greatest extent 74 allowed by law, all remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of the 75 76 Ordinance shall remain valid, constitutional, enforceable and of full force and effect.

Section 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby
 expressly repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. The City Clerk is authorized to execute, attest to, and seal any documents
which may be necessary to effectuate this ordinance, subject to approval as to form by the
City Attorney.

Section 6. Penalties in effect for violations of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of
Forest Park, Georgia at the time of the effective date of this Ordinance shall be and are
hereby made applicable to this Ordinance and shall remain in full force and effect.

85 <u>Section 7.</u> This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by
86 the Mayor and City Council of the City of Forest Park as provided in the City Charter.

87 <u>Section 8.</u> The City Clerk, with the concurrence of the City Attorney, authorized to
 88 correct any scrivener's errors found in this Ordinance, including any exhibits, as enacted.
