ARTICLE II, UNIFORM TRAFFIC CODE,
SECTION 62-31-ONE-WAY TRAFFIC EXEMPTION
FOR GARBAGE REFUSE VEHICLES

An Ordinance to enforce exemption of one-way traffic for garbage refuse vehicles.

THE CITY OF IRON MOUNTAIN ORDAINS:

Sec. 62-31.-One-Way Traffic Exemption for Garbage Refuse Vehicles

1. The city has certain designated one-way streets within its street and alley system. The city desires to allow garbage trucks to proceed in the opposite direction of one-way traffic under the following conditions:
 - (a) All garbage refuse vehicles must be equipped with approved flashing lights and appropriate warning devices acceptable to the city;
 - (b) The garbage refuse vehicles shall not exceed speeds of 15mph;
 - (c) Garbage refuse vehicles traveling in the opposite direction on a one-way designated street shall be actively engaged in the collection of refuse pursuant to its contractual obligations with the city;
 - (d) Garbage refuse vehicles shall stop at every intersecting roadway and proceed with caution while traveling in the opposite direction on a one-way designated street.
2. PENALTY FOR VIOLATION.
 - (a) Any vehicle operator who violates the provisions under I(c) of this ordinance may be cited under the uniform traffic code.
 - (b) Any vehicle operator who violates the provisions under I(d) of this ordinance may be issued a civil infraction, fines being as follows:

First offense: \$25.00
Second offense: \$50.00
Third offense: \$100.00

EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective in the City of Iron Mountain following adoption by the City Council and upon publication.
