An Ordinance Amending the Impact Fee Ordinance of the Village of Hammond

The Village Board of the Village of Hammond does ordain as follows:

SECTION I. SECTION AMENDED

Subparagraph “(5)” of Paragraph “(f),” entitled “Collection,” of Section 62-20, entitled “Impact fees,” of Article I, entitled “In General,” of Chapter 62, entitled “Subdivisions,” of the Municipal Code of the Village of Hammond is hereby amended to read as follows [removed language is struck through; added language is underlined]:

Article I. IN GENERAL

Sec. 62-20 Impact fees.

.....

(f) Collection. Impact fees shall be collected as follows:

~~(5) Any reduction in the number of water meters at a premises that continues for a period of at least twelve (12) months cannot be reinstated without payment of the impact fee due for any reinstated units or meters. The Village Board, upon written request, may in its discretion waive the requirement of paying an impact fee for a reinstated unit or meter as provided in this Subparagraph “(5).” Waiver of this requirement will only be granted when in the furtherance of a legitimate public purpose, including without limitation, the desire to encourage the sale and occupancy of vacant structures located within the village.~~

SECTION II. SEVERABILITY


If any provision of this Ordinance or any application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or unconstitutional, such a finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or applications.

SECTION III. EFFECTIVE DATE


This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage as provided by law.
