PREAMBLE AND FINDINGS

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE

An Ordinance To Provide For Adoption Of A Budget Amendment Containing Estimates Of Revenue And Expenditure Changes For The City Of Fayetteville, Georgia For The Fiscal Year Beginning August 1, 2014 And Ending July 31, 2015.

Be It Ordained By the Mayor and Council of the City of Fayetteville, Georgia:

Section 1. That For The Revenues And Expenditures Of The Government And Its Activities For The Fiscal Year, Beginning August 1, 2014 And Ending July 31, 2015 The Amounts In The Following Sections Are Hereby Amended.

Section 2. That For The Said Fiscal Year The General Fund and The Water and Sewer Fund, Is Hereby Amended As Follows:
