

AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "TOWN OF FOSTER SOIL EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL ORDINANCES" ADOPTED DECEMBER 10, 1987 AND LAST AMENDED MARCH 2, 2009.

It is ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Foster (the "Town") that the Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Ordinance adopted December 10, 1987, as last amended on March 2, 2009, (Chapter 26 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Foster, Rhode Island) is hereby amended by specifically amending the text of ARTICLE V. SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD AREAS AND FLOOD FRINGE LANDS: SECTION 26-132 as follows:

Sec. 26-132. - Purpose

The purpose of this article is to ensure public safety; minimize hazards to persons and property from flooding, to protect watercourses from encroachment and to maintain the capability of floodplains to retain and carry off floodwaters. *The Town of Foster elects to comply with the requirements of the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968 (P.L. 90-488, as amended).*
