

ORDINANCE 2026-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2026 GENERAL FUND BUDGETS TO RECOGNIZE ADDITIONAL EXPENSES OF \$334,000 FOR EXPENSE OF DUNE WALKOVER REPAIRS PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; CONFLICT; AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 2026-02, the City of Treasure Island, Florida adopted an annual operating budget for fiscal year 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City shall spend money exceeding the Fiscal Year 2026 Approved Budget in the amount of \$334,000.00 for the expense of repairs to the Dune Walkovers.

WHEREAS, this ordinance is a budget amendment and therefore, pursuant to s. 166.041(4)(c), Fla. Stat., this ordinance is exempt from the business impact estimate requirement of s. 166.041(4)(a), Fla. Stat.; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City's Charter and generally accepted accounting principles, the City finds it in the public's best interest to amend the City's budget to recognize the additional expenses of \$334,000.00 in General Fund toward the expense of repairs to the Dune Walkovers.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND DOES ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. The recitals set forth in the "Whereas" clauses above are ratified and confirmed as true and correct and are hereby adopted as findings by the City Commission of the City of Treasure Island, Florida for the adoption of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. The budget for the City of Treasure Island, Florida for the fiscal year 2026, as adopted pursuant to Ordinance 2026-02 is hereby amended by adding expenses of \$334,000.00 in General Fund toward the expense of repairs to the Dune Walkovers.

SECTION 3. That allocation of said funds shall be as follows:

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. It is declared to be the intent of the City Commission, that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 5. CONFLICT. This action supersedes all ordinances and resolutions of the City or portions thereof, in conflict with or inconsistent with this ordinance, to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage.

FIRST READING and PUBLIC HEARING on the 17th day of February, 2026.

SECOND READING and PUBLIC HEARING on the 16th day of March, 2026.
