#### **RESOLUTION NO. 23-1641**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LONGWOOD, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING A FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT; REPEALING RESOLUTION 22-1608; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Longwood has determined that amendments to the City Fee Schedule are desirable;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LONGWOOD, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. That the following schedule of fees be established for Community Development and Right-of-way Utilization.
