ORDINANCE NO. 136

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE II OF CHAPTER 22 TITLED “JUNK MOTOR VEHICLES” OF THE OXFORD CHARTER TOWNSHIP CODE BY AMENDING SECTIONS 22-34 AND 22-35.

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF OXFORD ORDAINS:

SECTION 1 – AMENDMENT

The Oxford Charter Township Code is hereby amended as follows:

1. Section 22-34 of Article II of Chapter 22 of the Oxford Charter Township Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Sec. 22-34. - Permit for additional time for making repairs.

Any person owning an unlicensed, dismantled, partially dismantled, or inoperable motor vehicle who is repairing or intending to repair such motor vehicle may apply to the township building department for a permit to allow such vehicle to remain on the premises for an additional ten-day period from the date of notice of such violation. Such permit, if approved, shall be issued for a sum as established by township board resolution, with such monies being nonreturnable to the person, and such monies shall be deposited in the general fund of the township.”

2. Section 22-35 of Article II of Chapter 22 of the Oxford Charter Township Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Sec. 22-35. - Penalties and enforcement.

- (a) A person who violates any provision of this article, or who violates any of the terms or conditions of any permit issued pursuant to this article, is responsible for a municipal civil infraction and shall be subject to a fine and payment of costs and to such other and further sanctions, judicial orders, and remedies as are authorized by state law including those set forth in Sections 1-7(e), 1-7(f), 1-7(g), and 1-7(h) of the Oxford Charter Township Code. Each day that a violation of this article or a violation of any of the terms or conditions of a permit issued pursuant to this article continues to exist shall constitute a separate offense. In addition, the Township may pursue any injunctive or other relief which may be available. Nothing in this section 22-35 shall be construed to limit the remedies available to

the Township in the event of a violation by any person of this article or of any of the terms or conditions of any permit issued pursuant to this article.

- (b) This article shall be administered and enforced by the ordinance enforcement officer of the township or by such other person(s) as designated by the township supervisor from time to time.”

SECTION 2 – SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any clause, sentence, word, section or provision is hereafter declared invalid or unenforceable for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect the remainder of such ordinance which shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 3 – REPEALER

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed only to the extent necessary to give this ordinance full force and effect.

SECTION 4 – SAVINGS CLAUSE

All proceedings pending and all rights and liabilities existing, acquired or incurred at the time this ordinance takes effect are saved and may be consummated according to the law in force when they are commenced.

SECTION 5 – EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days from the date of publication in accordance with law.
