

ORDINANCE NO. 2186-17

**AN ORDINANCE GRANTING AN EASEMENT TO ALABAMA POWER COMPANY
AND AUTHORIZING MAYOR JAMES HEIGL TO EXECUTE SAME**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SYLACAUGA, ALABAMA, AS
FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Mayor James Heigl is hereby authorized to execute an easement in favor of Alabama Power Company granting permission to cross a portion of property owned by the City of Sylacauga along Billingsley Road for the purpose of installing a new electrical service to the IDB Speculative Building to be utilized by Fleetwood Metal Industries, Inc.

Section 2. That said real estate which is subject of such easement to be described and attached hereto is not needed for municipal purposes, and is hereby declared surplus.

Section 3. That said execution of said easement shall be subject to approval by the FAA and a determination that said real estate across which the easement will be granted is not part of the ALP.

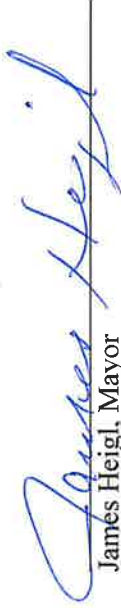

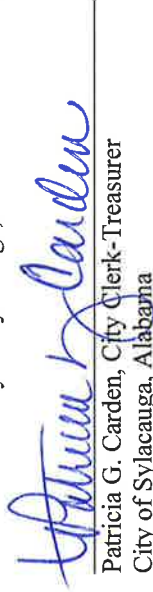
