ORDINANCE # 102-2-2022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CONVERSE, TEXAS REPEALING CHAPTER 2. ADMINISTRATION, ARTICLE III. BOARDS, COMMITTEES AND COMMISSIONS, DIVISION 8. CONVERSE HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; AFFIRMING THE DISSOLUTION OF THE CONVERSE HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE NECESSARY ACTIONS FOR THE DISSOLUTION OF THE COMMISSION; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on April 18, 2017 the City Council of the City of Converse created the Converse Historic Preservation Commission to establish a museum and park on the Schumann-Scheel Homestead for promoting and preserving the history of the City of Converse; and,

WHEREAS, the goals of the Converse Historic Preservation Commission were to educate the public into growing awareness, understanding, and appreciation of cultural and artistic values in the history of the City; and,

WHEREAS, the Converse Historic Preservation Commission Members, Liaisons and Staff successfully fulfilled their purpose by opening a park and museum to the public on November 6, 2021, now known as the Anton Schumann Park, located at 10565 Old Cimarron Trail, Converse, Texas.

WHEREAS, the City of Converse City Council appreciates the service and commitments the Converse Historic Preservation Commission Members, Liaisons, and Staff dedicated and contributed to the successful opening of the Anton Schumann Park.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONVERSE, TEXAS:


1. THAT, Chapter 2, Administration, Article III. Boards, Committees and Commissions, Division 8. Converse Historic Preservation Commission, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Converse, Texas is hereby Repealed and Deleted from the Code of Ordinances.
2. THAT, the Converse City Council Affirms the Dissolution of the Converse Historic Preservation Commission, and hereby relieves the Members and Liaisons appointed to the Converse Historic Preservation Commission from the duties therein prescribed.
3. THAT, the City Manager is hereby authorized to take any necessary actions as may be required for the Dissolution of the Converse Historic Preservation Commission.

4. EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall become effective after its Second Reading and publication in the newspaper as provided by the City Charter of the City of Converse, Texas.

5. REPEALER. This Ordinance repeals all previous versions in conflict with the purpose of this ordinance relating to Article III. Boards, Committees and Commissions, Division 8. Converse Historic Preservation Commission of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Converse, Texas
