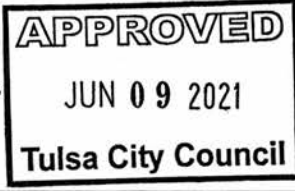

ORDINANCE NO. 24624

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11-C, TULSA REVISED ORDINANCES, TITLED "WATERWORKS AND SEWERAGE"; AMENDING CHAPTER 7, TITLED "SANITARY SEWER USER CHARGE SYSTEM"; AMENDING SECTION 702 TO ADJUST SEWER SERVICE CHARGE RATES; PROVIDING THAT THESE RATES SHALL BE EFFECTIVE ON OCTOBER 1, 2021; ESTABLISHING WHEN THE AMENDMENTS ENACTED BY THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME OPERATIVE; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TULSA:

*Section 1. That Title 11-C, Chapter 7, Section 702 Tulsa Revised Ordinances, be and the same is hereby amended to read and become operative on and after October 1, 2021 as follows:*

**"Section 702. Rates of user charge**

For the purpose of providing funds for the maintenance, repair, operation, expansion, replacement, or reconstruction of the sanitary sewer system of the City or other sanitary sewer systems of which the City has accepted or shall accept a beneficial interest and for other purposes, sewer service charges and industrial user waste charges shall be established as provided in this section. The rates so established shall become operative on October 1, 2021, for all billing cycles provided in this title with "service from date" on or after October 1, 2021.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11-C, TULSA REVISED ORDINANCES, TITLED "WATERWORKS AND SEWERAGE"; AMENDING CHAPTER 7, TITLED "SANITARY SEWER USER CHARGE SYSTEM"; AMENDING SECTION 702 TO ADJUST SEWER SERVICE CHARGE RATES; PROVIDING THAT THESE RATES SHALL BE EFFECTIVE ON OCTOBER 1, 2021; ESTABLISHING WHEN THE AMENDMENTS ENACTED BY THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME OPERATIVE; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TULSA:

Section 1. That Title 11-C, Chapter 7, Section 702 Tulsa Revised Ordinances, be and the same is hereby amended to read and become operative on and after October 1, 2021 as follows:

"Section 702. Rates of user charge
