

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2021-10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SEC. 24-56. AND SEC. 24-58. OF THE SCOTT MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Scott desires to amend Sec. 24-56. Definitions. of the Scott Municipal Code, to add a definition for Tents; and

FURTHER, WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Scott desires to amend Sec. 24-58. Declared., to declare that a Tent which is being used as a temporary or permanent residence for any length of time a public nuisance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council for the City of Scott, in regular session assembled, that Sec. 24-56. Definitions., is amended to add the following definition for Tents, to-wit:

Sec. 24-56. Definitions.

TENTS means a collapsible shelter of fabric.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council for the City of Scott, in regular session assembled, that Sec. 24-58. Declared., is amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Sec. 24-58. Declared.

The presence of any junked item on any public or private property, occupied or unoccupied, improved or unimproved, shall be deemed and is hereby declared a public nuisance; and it shall be unlawful for any person to cause or maintain such a public nuisance by wrecking, dismantling, partially dismantling, rendering inoperable, abandoning, or discarding any junked item on the real property of another or to suffer, permit, or allow any junked item to be parked, left, or maintained on his own real property, provided that this section shall not apply with regard to:

- (1) Any junked item in an enclosed building or structure;
(2) Any junked item on the premises of a business enterprise operated in a lawful manner; when necessary to the operation of such business enterprise, lawfully licensed by the city; or
(3) Any junked item situated in an appropriate storage place or depository maintained at a location where such storage place or depository is authorized under the regulatory ordinances of the city.

The presence of any tent which is being used as a temporary or permanent residence for any length of time on any public or private property, occupied or unoccupied, improved or unimproved, shall be deemed and is hereby declared a public nuisance.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption. Any provisions of the Code or ordinances which are in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
