

RESOLUTION NO. 4062

(HIDTA – Southern Nevada Heroin and Money Laundering Initiative)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HENDERSON, NEVADA TO ACCEPT NEW FUNDING UNDER THE COST REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT NEVADA HIDTA FUNDS BETWEEN THE LAS VEGAS METROPOLITAN POLICE DEPARTMENT, THE HENDERSON POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE NEVADA HIGH INTENSITY DRUG TRAFFICKING AREA (NV HIDTA) FOR THE REIMBURSEMENT OF JOINT OPERATIONS EXPENSES FROM THE OFFICE OF NATIONAL DRUG CONTROL POLICY FUND.

WHEREAS, the City of Henderson, Nevada (the "City"), is charged with providing police services to the citizens of Henderson; and

WHEREAS, identification, prosecution, disruption and dismantling of drug trafficking organizations that are smuggling and distributing heroin in Southern Nevada must be deterred, defeated, and responded to vigorously and apprehension of individuals and/or organizations who may commit or plan to commit such acts is essential to maintaining our community well being, and

WHEREAS, it is in the public's best interest that any suspected activities be investigated and managed by a coordinated task force effort made up of federal, state and local law enforcement; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Henderson, Nevada that:

SECTION 1. The City hereby accepts the funding which will be reimbursed under the existing Cost Reimbursement Agreement Nevada HIDTA Funds between the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department (LVMPD), the Henderson Police Department (HPD), and the Nevada High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (NV HIDTA) and the Henderson Police Department, as set forth in Exhibit A, consisting of three pages, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference

Exhibit A

Cost Reimbursement Agreement Nevada HIDTA Funds

This Agreement is made between the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department (LVMPD) and the Henderson Police Department (HPD), participating agencies in the Nevada High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (NV HIDTA).

Whereas the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department has been selected by the Executive Board of the Nevada High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (NV HIDTA), and approved by the Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP), to be the fiduciary agency for the Nevada HIDTA, this Agreement sets forth the cost reimbursement process between the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department and the Henderson Police Department.

The Henderson Police Department agrees to adhere to all policies as set forth in the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area Program Policy and Budget Guidance Manual as approved by the Acting Director of the Office of National Drug Control Policy on September 27, 2001. **Special attention is directed to Section XI, 11.01, Terms and Conditions on Use of HIDTA Funds; Section XI, 11.06, Restricted Expenditures, and Section XI, 11.07, Unallowable Expenditures.**

Cost reimbursements are for identified allowable expenses in each Initiative in which the Henderson Police Department is participating. All cost reimbursements are subject to Initiative Manager and HIDTA Director approval in advance of incurring the expense. Allowable expenses are identified as: (1) Overtime, (2) Travel/Training, and (3) Purchase of Evidence or Purchase of Information (PE/PI).

The Henderson Police Department agrees to submit to the LVMPD HIDTA Grant Specialist a monthly reimbursement request, with supporting documentation, for funds paid by the Henderson Police Department for allowable expenses as noted above. Supporting documentation includes but is not limited to: (1) original receipts for all travel related expenses, except per diem (meals), (2) copies of overtime slips and payroll verification of payment, and (3) copies of Henderson Police Department proof of payments for evidence and/or payments for information. Requests for reimbursement must be submitted within 60 days of the date the expense was incurred.

The Henderson Police Department agrees to ensure that overtime paid to an officer/investigator does not exceed the annual overtime cap set by ONDCP. This cap is the equivalent of 25% of the salary of a Federal GS-10, Step 1, and is based on the fiscal year of the LVMPD (July 1 through June 30).


The terms of this Agreement are in effect subject to the availability of funds from the Office of National Drug Control Policy and shall commence on the latest date of signature of the agency heads identified below.

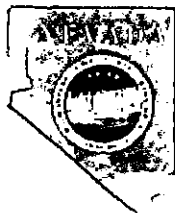
