AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ARTICLE XII OF CHAPTER 42- TRAFFIC AND MOTOR VEHICLES REGULATIONS AND REPLACING WITH A NEW ARTICLE XII, STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING RESTRICTED OR PROHIBITED ON CERTAIN STREET REGULATIONS TO THE RAYTOWN MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, the current version of Article XII of Chapter 42 of the Raytown Municipal Code lists all of the areas within the City where no parking or restricted parking signs are or should be placed; however, the street descriptions do not adequately match where the no parking signs or restricted parking signs are actually placed; and

WHEREAS, to protect public health, safety and general welfare of the people in the City it is necessary to amend the Raytown Municipal Code;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF RAYTOWN, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1 – AMENDMENT. Chapter 42, Traffic and Motor Vehicles, Article XII, Stopping, Standing or Parking Restricted or Prohibited on Certain Streets is hereby repealed and replaced with a new Chapter 42, Article XII as attached hereto as Exhibit "A" to the Raytown Municipal Code.

SECTION 2 – REPEAL OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3 – SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. The provisions of this ordinance are severable and if any provision hereof is declared invalid, unconstitutional or unenforceable, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance.

SECTION 4 – EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

Exhibit A

ARTICLE XII. - STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING RESTRICTED OR PROHIBITED ON CERTAIN STREETS

Sec. 42-372. - Application of chapter.

The provisions of this chapter prohibiting the standing or parking of a vehicle shall apply at all times or at those times herein specified or as indicated on official signs except when it is necessary to stop a vehicle to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or official traffic control device.

Sec. 42-373. - Regulations not exclusive.

The provisions of this chapter imposing a time limit on parking shall not relieve any person from the duty to observe other and more restrictive provisions prohibiting or limiting the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles in specified places or at specified times.

Sec. 42-374. - Parking prohibited at all times on certain streets.

When signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the following streets:

- (1) Blue Ridge Extension and Blue Ridge cut-off from south city limits to north city limits

 Boulevard from 51st Street to 59th Street (both sides of street).
- (2) West side of Blue Ridge Boulevard from 59th Street to 60th Terrace.

- (4) North side of 60th Terrace from Blue Ridge Boulevard to 128 feet west of the centerline of Blue Ridge Boulevard.

- (6) Blue Ridge Cutoff from 66th Street to north city limits (both sides of street).

Sec. 42-375. - Parking restricted during certain hours on certain streets.

- (a) Generally. When signs are erected in each block giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle between the hours specified by ordinance on any day except Sunday and public holidays within the districts or upon any of the streets described by ordinance.
- (b) Specific hours. In accordance with this section and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle within the hours specified herein on any day except Sundays and public holidays within the district or upon any of the streets or parts of streets as set forth herein as follows:
 - (1) Two-hour parking. Stopping, standing or parking for more than two hours between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. is prohibited on the following streets or parts of streets:
 - a. **South side of** 63rd Street, between **Evanston Ave. and Raytown Road.** Arlington Street and Cedar Street.
 - b. Raytown Road, east side of 63rd Street from 140' south of 63rd Street to 63rd Terrace, between 62nd Street and 64th Street (except as otherwise provided herein).
 - c. East side of Blue Ridge Boulevard from 168 feet north of the centerline of 63rd Street to 228 feet north of the centerline of 63rd Street.
 - d. West side of Blue Ridge Boulevard from 311 feet north of the centerline of 63rd Street to 571 feet north of the centerline of 63rd Street.
 - e. West side of Blue Ridge Boulevard from 1135 feet north of the centerline of 63rd Street to 1253 feet north of the centerline of 63rd Street.
 - f. North side of 60th Terrace from 22 feet west of the centerline of Blue Ridge Boulevard to 128 feet west of the centerline of Blue Ridge Boulevard.
 - **f.** g. South side of 60th Terrace from **Raytown Road to** 172 feet west of the centerline of Blue Ridge Boulevard to 404 feet west of the centerline of Blue Ridge Boulevard.
 - h. North side of 61 st Terrace from 180 feet west of the centerline of Blue Ridge Boulevard to the east right of way line of Raytown Road.
 - i. South side of 61 st Terrace from 344 feet west of the centerline of Blue Ridge Boulevard to the east right-of-way line of Raytown Road.
 - (2) Limited parking. Standing, stopping or parking during the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. shall be prohibited on the following streets or parts of streets: Raytown Road, west side only, between 63rd Street and south property line of Bowen Apartments.
 - a. Both sides of Cedar Ave., between 58th Terrace and 59th Street. (on Court Days)
 - b. East side of Cedar Ave., from 58th Terrace and north 300'. (on Court Days)

- (3) School parking zones. Parking during the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on weekdays while school is in session shall be prohibited on the following streets:
 - a. **Both sides of** 82nd Street, between Sterling and Harvard.
 - b. **South side of** 83rd Street, between **Harvard Ave.** Sterling and Pershing Road.
 - c. North side of 83rd Street between Sterling Ave. and Pershing Road.
 - c. Sterling, between 82nd Street and 84th Terrace.
 - d. North side of 60th Terrace from 128 feet west of the centerline of Blue Ridge Boulevard to the east right-of-way line of Raytown Road.
 - d. East side of Sterling Ave. from 83rd Street north 150'.
 - e. West side of Sterling Ave. from 82nd Street to 83rd Street.
 - f. East side of Willow Ave. from 60th Terrace and south 50'.
 - g. Both sides of Hardy Ave, between 61st Street and 61st Terrace.
- (4) No parking during business hours. Stopping, standing or parking during business hours between 8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. is prohibited on the following streets or parts of streets:
 - a. West side of Ash Ave., between 63rd Street and 63rd Terrace.
 - b. West side of Cedar Ave., between Maywood Ave. and 67th Street.
 - c. East side of Cedar Ave., from Maywood Ave. and south 120'.

Sec. 42-377. - Parking signs required.

Whenever by this chapter or any ordinance of the city, any parking time limit is imposed or parking is prohibited on designated streets, it shall be the duty of the city traffic engineer to erect appropriate signs giving notice thereof and no such regulations shall be effective unless said signs are erected and in place at the time of any alleged offense.

- Sec. 42-378. Parking of certain vehicles prohibited for more than two hours on residential streets.
 - (a) It shall be unlawful for the driver, owner, or operator of a bus, truck (except those motor vehicles commonly known as trucks one ton or less), tractor, trailer, recreational vehicle, house trailer, tractor-trailer, truck-trailer combination, road building machinery or any commercial vehicles, to park or cause

to be parked for longer than two hours in any one day on any street in a residential area, except that an operator may park said vehicle for a longer period while actually and continuously engaged in a loading or unloading, subject to all other ordinances regulating said prohibition.

(b) The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this section, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this subsection, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

Commercial vehicle means a motor vehicle designed or regularly used for carrying freight, merchandise, or other property or more than eight passengers and licensed in excess of 18,000 pounds.

Residential area means that area within the city limits zoned for residential use or principally used for residential purposes.

Tractor, tractor-trailer or truck-trailer combination means a self-propelled motor vehicle designed for drawing other vehicles.

Trailer means any vehicle without motive power designed for carrying property or passengers on its own structure and being drawn by a self-propelled vehicle, including a semitrailer or vehicle of the trailer type so designed and used in conjunction with a self-propelled vehicle that a considerable part of its own weight rests upon and is carried by the towing vehicle.

(c) No notice or sign reflecting said prohibition shall be required to be posted.

Sec. 42-379. - Commercial vehicles prohibited from using certain streets.

In cases where an equally direct and convenient alternate route is provided, an ordinance may be described and signs may be erected giving notice thereof, that no persons shall operate any commercial vehicle upon streets or parts of streets so described except those commercial vehicles making deliveries thereon.
