ALTERATION OF SPEED LIMIT
CH 33/75TH STREET
FROM 500' EAST OF NAPER BOULEVARD TO IL ROUTE 53
(FROM 50 MPH TO 45 MPH)

WHEREAS, an engineering and traffic investigation has been made to determine the reasonable and proper speed limit along CH 33/75th Street, from 500' east of Naper Boulevard to Illinois Route 53; and

WHEREAS, the basic statutory vehicular speed limit established by Section 625 ILCS 5/11-601 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes is greater than that considered reasonable and proper on this section of 75th Street, as noted in the following Schedule, for which the DuPage County Division of Transportation has maintenance responsibility, and which are not under the jurisdiction of the Illinois Department of Transportation.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of DuPage County, Illinois, that by virtue of Section 625 ILCS 5/11-604 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, this Board determines and declares that reasonable and proper absolute maximum speed limit upon the above referenced section 75th Street shall be as stated therein; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that upon approval of this Ordinance, signs giving notice thereof shall be erected in conformance with the standards and specifications contained in the Illinois Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately after the erection of said signs giving notice of the maximum speed limit; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the County Clerk is hereby directed to forward one (1) certified copy of this Ordinance to the DuPage County Division of Transportation.
