

**VILLAGE OF WINDSOR
VILLAGE BOARD ORDINANCE 2024-04**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE 1, SECTION 2-2 OF THE
WINDSOR CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING PUBLICATION**

WHEREAS, effective on April 12, 2024, the DeForest Tribune and the Sun Prairie Star will merge into one newspaper called "The Star"; and

WHEREAS, the Village had designated the DeForest Times Tribune as the official newspaper of the Village of Windsor;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Windsor, Dane County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Article 1, Section 2-2 of the Windsor Code of Ordinances is hereby repealed and replaced as set forth below:

Sec. 2-2. - Legal posting and publication; designation of official newspaper.

Method of notice and posting: The Village shall use posting pursuant to State law.


Publication: When publication is required by state law or when publication is directed by the Village Board, the official newspaper shall be The Star.

SECTION 2. All other provisions of Code of Ordinances not specifically amended herein shall remain unmodified and in full force and effect.


SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.

The above and foregoing Ordinance was duly adopted at a meeting of the Village Board of the Village of Windsor held on March 21, 2024 by a vote of 5 in favor and 0 opposed.

Effective on April 12, 2024, the DeForest Tribune and the Sun Prairie Star will merge into one newspaper called "The Star." "The Star" will remain a newspaper that is Certified to Publish Legal Notices in the State of Wisconsin.

The DeForest Tribune will remain a recognized Certified Paper until its final edition on Friday, April 5, 2024. Legal notices that are required to run in consecutive editions should not be published in the DeForest Tribune if the consecutive run requirement would extend beyond the April 5 edition.

There's no change in the legal certification status or the ability to publish legal notices in the Sun Prairie Star. Notices that need to run consecutively can run in the newly named "The Star."
