

ORDINANCE NO. 24-09-03

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 48 PEDDLERS, SOLICITORS AND
ITINERANT VENDORS.**

WHEREAS, the Town of Pecos City Texas ("City"), is a home rule municipality operating pursuant to its Charter and the laws of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 48 of the City Code of Ordinances currently allows for a variety of vendors to sell withing the Town of Pecos City limits; and

WHEREAS, The City desires to allow vendors to sale;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF
PECOS CITY, TEXAS THAT:**

That Section 48-5 of this code of ordinances, Town of Pecos City, Texas, is hereby amended to reflect the Master Fee Schedule


