### AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF VAN ALSTYNE, TEXAS, AMENDING WATER AND SEWER RATES OUTSIDE CITY LIMITS IN THE FEE SCHEDULE ADOPTED BY SECTION 2-183 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR REPEALING, SAVINGS AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Van Alstyne ("City Council") has determined that it would be advantageous and beneficial to the citizens of the City of Van Alstyne, Texas ("Van Alstyne") to amend Van Alstyne's fee schedule for fees related to water usage and sewage collection and treatment for the City as set forth below; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has authority under state law to adopt the rates herein.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VAN ALSTYNE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: Findings Incorporated. The findings set forth above are incorporated as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2: Amendment to City Fee Schedule, Chapter 2, Section 2-183 of Van Alstyne's Code of Ordinances. The City fee schedule, adopted by Section 2-183 of the Code of Ordinances, is hereby amended in accordance with Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, to adopt the water and sewer rates set forth therein. No other fees are amended by this Ordinance.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: <u>Savings/Repealing Clause</u>. Van Alstyne's fee schedule, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, save and except as amended by this or any other ordinance. All provisions of any ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent they are in conflict; but such repeal shall not abate any pending prosecution for violation of the repealed ordinance, nor shall the repeal prevent a prosecution from being commenced for any violation if occurring prior to the repeal of the ordinance. Any remaining portions of said ordinances shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>SECTION 4</u>: <u>Severability</u>. Should any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is expressly provided that any and all remaining portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Van Alstyne hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

<u>SECTION 5</u>: <u>Effective Date</u>. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after its adoption and publication as required by law. The rates will apply to utility bills sent to customers on or after April 1, 2024.
