ORDINANCE NO. 2264

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO, REAPPORTIONING, REDISTRICTING, AND ESTABLISHING NEW WARD BOUNDARIES FOR WARDS 3 AND 4, AND CORRECTING LEGAL DESCRIPTIONS FOR ALL WARDS BY AMENDING SECTIONS OF THE GOLDEN MUNICIPAL CODE IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH

WHEREAS, pursuant to Charter Section 3.2 "Wards and Districts" of the City of Golden's Municipal Code, all wards shall have approximately the same number of registered voters, as determined by the number registered to vote at the preceding general municipal election; and

WHEREAS, the variances in said number of registered voters shall not be greater than fifteen per cent between the ward with the highest number of registered voters and the ward with the lowest number of registered voters; and

WHEREAS, City Council shall, at least six months prior to the second general municipal election to be held after the adoption of this home rule charter, and every four years thereafter, make such divisions, changes and consolidations as are necessary to carry out the intent of Charter Section 3.2; and

WHEREAS, 2007 was the last time City Council made any changes to the wards; and

WHEREAS, the variance between Ward Three, with the highest number of registered voters, and Ward Four, with the lowest number of registered voters, is greater than fifteen per cent; and

WHEREAS, while establishing the new boundaries for the Third and Fourth Wards, staff identified a need to make technical corrections to the legal descriptions for all Wards; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that changes to the Wards are necessary to carry out the intent of Charter Section 3.2.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDEN, COLORADO:

Section 1. The recitals contained above are incorporated herein by reference and are adopted as findings and determinations of City Council.

Section 2. Section 1.04.050, Golden Municipal Code, "Third ward boundary designated is hereby amended to read as follows, with additions shown in <u>underline</u> and deletions shown in <u>strikethrough</u>:

1.04.050 - Third ward boundary designated.

That portion of the city described as follows shall be designated as Ward Three:

Beginning at a point where the South line of Section 21, T3S, R70W, erosses intersects the eenterline Easterly right-of-way line of Colorado Highway 93; thence nNorthwesterly along the existing said Easterly right-of-way line to the Northerly city limits to the NW corner of Section 21, T3S, R70W; thence easterly to the Colorado Highway 93 ROW; thence southeasterly Easterly and Southeasterly along the existing city limits to the SE corner of Section 21, T3S, R70W; thence easterly along the north line of Section 27, T3S, R70W to a point; thence south easterlyclockwise along the existing city limits to the nNorth ROW line of W. 44th Avenue; thence northeasterly Northeasterly along the existing city limits along W. 44th Avenue andto the existing city limits to the Salvia Street ROWat the Coors Technology Center development; thence westerly clockwise along the existing city limits to a point on the at the Coors Technology Center development to the Easley Road ROW; thence northerly along the existing city limits along Easley Road and following the existing city limits to a point; thence northeasterly clockwise along the existing city limits to the NE corner of Section 23, T3S, R70W; thence northerly along the existing city limits to W. 50th Avenue; thence easterly clockwise along the existing city limits to the intersection of the South ROW of W. 50th Avenue with the West ROW of McIntrye Street and W. 50th Avenue ROW intersection; thence sSoutherly along the existing city limits along McIntrye Street ROW and to the <u>intersection with the existing city limits toof</u> the McIntrye StreetSouth ROW intersection and theof W. 44th Avenue south ROW intersection; thence Southwesterly along the southexisting city limits along W. 44th Avenue ROW and existing to the city limits to at approximately the North-South centerline of Section 27, T3S, R70W; thence Southerly clockwise along the existing city limits through the Southwest Quarter of Section 27, T3S, R70W to the North-South centerline of Section 27, T3S, R70W; thence southerly and easterly Southerly along the existing city limits to a point on along the North-South centerline of South Golden Road; thence northerly Section 27, T3S, R70W to the North line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 34, T3S, R70W; thence Easterly along the existing city limits along said North line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 34, T3S, R70W, and along the North line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 35, T3S, R70W to the city limits at approximately the East line of the West Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 35, T3S, R70W; thence Southerly along the existing city limits along said East line of the West Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 35, T3S, R70W to the intersection with the South line of said Northwest Quarter of Section 35, T3S, R70W; thence

departing said existing city limits, Southwesterly approximately 380 feet to the most Easterly corner of the strip of land conveyed to Jefferson County in the Special Warranty Deed recorded at Reception No. 2018098695; thence Southwesterly along the Easterly line of said strip of land and it's Southwesterly projection to the intersection with the North ROW line of Rimrock Drive, as dedicated in Rimrock Subdivision, according to the recorded plat thereof; thence Westerly along said North ROW line, and it's Southwesterly projection to the centerline of South Golden Road; thence Northerly along the centerline of South Golden Road and continuing along the centerline of Ford Street to the intersection with the centerline of 24th Street; thence eEasterly along the centerline of 24th Street to the intersection of the centerline of East Street; thence nNortherly along the centerline of East Street to the intersection of the centerline of 15th Street; thence *Westerly along the intersection of 15th Street to the intersection with the centerline of Washington Avenue; thence nNortherly along the centerline of Washington Avenue to the intersection of with the centerline Easterly right-of-way line of Colorado Highway 93; thence northerly Northerly along said Easterly right-of-way line to the point of beginning.

The <u>*Third</u> ward shall include any future <u>extension of annexations to</u> the city limits within or contiguous to the above-described land.

Section 3. Section 1.04.060, Golden Municipal Code, "Fourth ward boundary designated", is hereby amended to read as follows, with additions shown in <u>underline</u> and deletions shown in <u>strikethrough</u>:

1.04.060 - Fourth ward boundary designated.

That portion of the city described as follows shall be designated as Ward Four:

Beginning at a point where the sSouth line of Section 21, T3S, R70W, crosses intersects the centerline Westerly right-of-way line of Colorado Highway 93; thence southerly clockwise Northwesterly along the centerline existing city limits to the NW corner of Section 21, T3S, R70W; thence Easterly along the existing city limits to the intersection with the Easterly right-of-way line of Colorado Highway 93; thence Southerly along said Easterly right-of-way line of Colorado Highway 93 to the intersection with the centerline of Washington Avenue; thence sSoutherly along the centerline of Ushington Avenue to the intersection with the centerline of 15th Street; thence eEasterly along the centerline of 15th Street to the intersection with the centerline of 21st Street; thence sSoutherly along the centerline of 21st Street to the intersection with the centerline of 19th Street; thence mNortherly along the centerline of Illinois Street to the intersection with the centerline of 19th Street; thence mNortherly along the centerline of US Highway 6; thence mNortherly along the centerline of US

Highway 6 and existing city limits to a point on the north-south North-South centerline of Section 33, T3S, R70W, which point is on the; thence Southerly along said North-South centerline of Section 33, T3S, R70W to the existing westerly city limits; thence northerly along the South right-of-way of US Highway 6; thence clockwise along the Westerly existing westerly city limits to the West line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 33, T3S, R70W; thence along the existing city limits along said West line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 33, T3S, R70W and along the existing city limits along portions of the West line of Section 28, T3S, R70W to the NW corner of Section 28, T3S, R70W; thence easterly Easterly along the existing city limits to the point of beginning.—

The **<u>fF</u>**ourth ward shall include any future <u>expansion of annexations to</u> the city limits within or contiguous to the above-described land—<u>as approved and ordered by the City.</u>

Section 4. Section 1.04.030, Golden Municipal Code, "First ward boundary designated", is hereby amended to read as follows, with additions shown in <u>underline</u> and deletions shown in <u>strikethrough</u>:

1.04.030 – First ward boundary designated.

That portion of the city described as follows shall be designated as Ward One:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of the centerline of US Highway 6 and the centerline of 19th Street; thence southeasterly along the centerline of US Highway 6 to the intersection with the *West line of Section 2, T4S, R70W; thence sSouth along the wWest line of said Section 2 and continuing sSouth along the *West line of Section 11, T4S, R70W, to the intersection with the centerline of W. 4th Avenue; thence *West along the centerline of W. 4th Avenue to the intersection with the Northerly projection of the East line of Bachman Farm Filing No. 1, according to the recorded plat thereof; thence Southerly along said East line to the Southeast corner of said Bachman Farm Filing No. 1; thence Westerly along the Southerly limits of said Bachman Farm Filing No. 1 to the Southwest corner of said Bachman Farm Filing No. 1; thence Northerly along the Westerly limits of said Bachman Farm Filing No. 1, and its Northerly projection to the intersection with the centerline of W. 4th Avenue; thence West along the centerline of W. 4th Avenue to the city limits; thence southerly intersection with the centerline of Heritage Road; thence Southerly along the centerline of Heritage Road and continuing South along the centerline of U.S. Highway 40 to the intersection with the existing city limits; thence counterclockwise along the existing city limits to a point; thence easterly along the existing city limits through Sections 14, 11, 12, T4S, R70W to a point; thence southeasterly the existing city limits along the South side of the West 6th Avenue Frontage Road; thence Easterly along the existing city limits to a point; thence easterly along the South side of the West 6th Avenue Frontage Road to the

existing city limits to a point along the West side of Indiana Street; thence nSorutherly along the existing city limits to a point; thence northeasterly along the existing city limits to a point; thence southerlyalong the West side of Indiana Street and continuing counterclockwise along the existing eity limits to a point; thence easterlyCity limits through the Northwest Quarter of Section 7, T4S, R69W to the existing city limits along the West side of Indiana Street; thence Southerly along the existing city limits to a point; thence northerly along the West side of Indiana Street to the existing city limits to a point; thence westerly along the North side of the West 6th Avenue Frontage Road; thence Westerly along the existing city limits to a point; thence northeasterly along the existing city limits to a point; thence westerly along the North side of the West 6th Avenue Frontage Road and continuing counterclockwise along the existing City limits through Sections 12, 1, 2, 11, T4S, R70W to the existing city limits to a pointalong the East side of Ulysses Street; thence nNortherly along the existing city limits aloned the ROWEast side of Ulysses Street to a point; thence northeasterly and continuing counterclockwise along the existing city limits to a point; thence southwesterly to a point onthrough Sections 2, T4S, R70W and through Section 35, T3S, R70W to the intersection with the South line of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 35, T3S, R70W; thence Westerly along said South line to the intersection with the East line of the West Half of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 35; thence departing said existing city limits, Southwesterly approximately 380 feet to the most Easterly corner of the strip of land conveyed to Jefferson County in the Special Warranty Deed recorded at Reception No. 2018098695; thence Southwesterly along the Easterly line of said strip of land and it's Southwesterly projection to the intersection with the North ROW line of Rimrock Drive, as dedicated in Rimrock Subdivision, according to the recorded plat thereof; thence Westerly along said North ROW line, and it's Southwesterly projection to the centerline of South Golden Road; thence northerly along the centerline of South Golden Road and continuing along the centerline of Ford Street to the intersection with the centerline of 24th Street; thence eEasterly along the centerline of 24th Street to the intersection of east Street; thence northerly along the centerline of East Street to the intersection of with the centerline of 21st Street; thence wWesterly along the centerline of 21st Street to the intersection with the centerline of Illinois Street; thence nNortherly along the centerline of Illinois Street to the intersection of with the centerline of 19th Street; thence wWesterly along the centerline of 19th Street to the point of beginning.

The **f**rirst ward shall include any future extension of annexations to the city limits within or contiguous to the above-described land as approved and ordered by the City.

Section 6. Section 1.04.040, Golden Municipal Code, "Second ward boundary designated", is hereby amended to read as follows, with additions shown in <u>underline</u> and deletions shown in <u>strikethrough</u>:

1.04.040 - Second ward boundary designated.

That portion of the city described as follows shall be designated as Ward Two:

Beginning at a point where the north south North-South centerline of Section 33, T3S, R70W, intersects the centerline of US Highway 6; thence sSoutheasterly along the centerline of US Highway 6 to the intersection with the wWest line of Section 2, T4S, R70W; thence south along the west line of Section 2 and continuing sSouth along the wWest line of Section 11, T4S, R70W, to the intersection with the centerline of W. 4th Avenue; thence <u>wW</u>est along the centerline of W. 4th Avenue; to the intersection with the Northerly projection of the East line of Bachman Farm Filing No. 1, according to the recorded plat thereof; thence Southerly along said East line to the Southeast corner of said Bachman Farm Filing No. 1; thence Westerly along the Southerly limits of said Bachman Farm Filing No. 1 to the Southwest corner of said Bachman Farm Filing No. 1; thence Northerly along the Westerly limits of said Bachman Farm Filing No. 1, and its Northerly projection to the intersection with the centerline of W. 4th Avenue; thence West along the centerline of W. 4th Avenue to the intersection with the centerline of Heritage Road; thence southerly along the centerline of Heritage Road and continuing South along the centerline of U.S. Highway 40 to a point on the existing city limits; thence northerly clockwise along the existing city limits; thence running along the existing city limits and through Sections 15, 9, 3 and 4, T4S, R70W and along and through Section 33, T3S, R70W to the point of beginning.

The <u>sS</u>econd ward shall include any future <u>expansion of annexations to</u> the city limits within or contiguous to the above-described land—as approved and ordered by the City.

- **Section 6.** If any article, section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision will not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each part or parts hereof irrespective of the fact that any one part or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.
- **Section 7.** All other ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict.
- **Section 8.** The repeal or modification of any provision of the Municipal Code of the City of Golden by this ordinance shall not release, extinguish, alter, modify or change in whole or in part any penalty, forfeiture or liability, either civil or criminal, which shall have been incurred under such provision. Each provision shall be treated and held as still remaining in force for the purpose of sustaining any and all proper actions, suits, proceedings and prosecutions

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for enforcement of the penalty, forfeiture or liability, as well as for the purpose of sustaining any judgment, decree or order which can or may be rendered, entered or made in such actions, suits, proceedings or prosecutions.

Section 9. This ordinance is deemed necessary for the protection of the health, welfare and safety of the community.

Section 10. The codifier of the City's Municipal Code, Municode, is hereby authorized to make such numerical and formatting changes as may be necessary to incorporate the provisions of this ordinance within the Golden Municipal Code.

Section 11. This ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after publication following passage in accordance with Section 5.9 of the Charter for the City of Golden, Colorado.
