## **EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 70-2020**

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A THEN-AND-NOW CERTIFICATE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$19,751.68 TO BUTLER COUNTY WATER AND SEWER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, due to engineering design changes for the Monroe Bicentennial Commons Project, permit fees had to be paid in order to avoid stopping construction; therefor, there was not sufficient time to open a purchase order.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: A Then-and-Now Certificate in the amount of \$19,751.68 to Butler County Water and Sewer is hereby approved.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to authorize the Certificate at the earliest possible date to meet the deadline for approval of said Certificate within the time required by law. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
