

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 23

A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF SHAWNEE, KANSAS FROM THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 12-16,101 AND PROVIDING SUBSTITUTE AND ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS WHICH RELATE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CONVENTION AND TOURISM COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body adopted Charter Ordinance No. 18 on July 10, 1989, exempting the City from the provisions of K.S.A. 12-1697(a), which relate to the levy of a transient guest tax and which provided substitute and additional provisions for the levying of a transient guest tax;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Shawnee, Kansas:

SECTION 1. The City Shawnee, Kansas, under the power vested in it by Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, hereby exempts itself from the provisions of K.S.A. 12-16,101 which applies to the City and provides substitute and additional provisions for the establishment of a Convention and Tourism Committee as provided herein.

SECTION 2. There is hereby established a Convention and Tourism Committee to make recommendations concerning the programs and expenditures for the promotion of convention and tourism within the City. The individuals who from time to time hold the following offices or position shall be voting members of the committee:

- 1. The City Manager of the City of Shawnee;**
- 2. The Director of Parks and Recreation for the City of Shawnee;**
- 3. The President of the Shawnee Chamber of Commerce;**
- 4. The Chief Executive Officer of the Shawnee Chamber of Commerce.**

Five additional members shall be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the Governing Body. One member appointed by the Mayor shall be a representative of a "business" as that term is defined in K.S.A. 12-1692, two members appointed by the Mayor shall be council members of the City of Shawnee, and two members shall be representatives of businesses or professions. Any member serving in any of the aforementioned representative capacities shall cease to be a member of the committee as such time as they no longer qualify to serve in that representative capacity. The Mayor of the City of Shawnee shall be an ex officio non-voting member of the committee. The terms of office for members of the committee appointed by the Mayor shall be:

1. One member to be appointed for an initial term ending one year from the effective date of this Ordinance.
2. Two members to be appointed for an initial term ending two years from the effective date of this Ordinance.
3. Two members to be appointed for an initial term ending three years from the effective date of this Ordinance.


Upon the expiration of the initial terms all subsequent terms shall be three years.

SECTION 3. This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the official City newspaper and shall take effect 61 days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum is held as provided in Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case, this Ordinance shall become effective if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

PASSED BY the Governing Body of the City of Shawnee, Kansas, not less than two-thirds of the members elect voting in favor thereof, this 25th day of August, 1997.

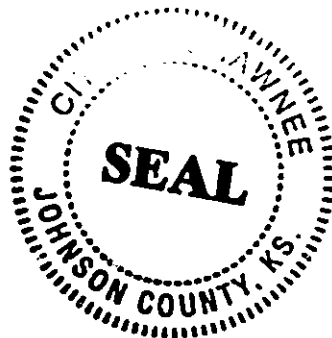

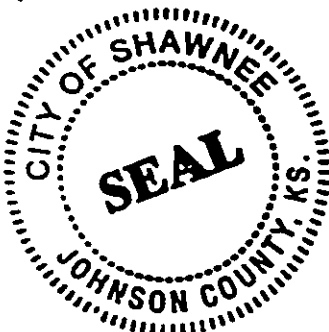

WHEREAS, the Governing Body adopted Charter Ordinance No. 13 July 10, 1993, exempting the City from the provisions of K.S.A. 12-16,101, which relate to the levy of a transient guest tax and which provided substitute and additional provisions for the levying of a transient guest tax;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Shawnee, Kansas:

SECTION 1. The City Shawnee, Kansas, under the power vested in it by Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, hereby exempts itself from the provisions of K.S.A. 12-16,101 which applies to the City and provides substitute and additional provisions for the establishment of a Convention and Tourism Committee as provided herein.

SECTION 2. There is hereby established a Convention and Tourism Committee to make recommendations concerning the programs and expenditures for the promotion of convention and tourism within the City. The individuals who from time to time hold the following offices or position shall be voting members of the committee:

1. The City Manager of the City of Shawnee;
2. The Director of Parks and Recreation for the City of Shawnee;
3. The President of the Shawnee Chamber of Commerce;
4. The Chief Executive Officer of the Shawnee Chamber of Commerce.

Five additional members shall be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the Governing Body. One member appointed by the Mayor shall be a representative of a "business" as that term is defined in K.S.A. 12-16,102, two members appointed by the Mayor shall be full members of the City of Shawnee, and two members shall be representatives of businesses or professions. Any member serving any of the aforementioned representative capacities shall cease to be a member of the committee as such time as they no longer qualify to serve in that representative capacity. The Mayor of the City of Shawnee shall be an ex officio non-voting member of the committee. The terms of office for members of the committee appointed by the Mayor shall be:

1. One member to be appointed for an initial term ending one year from the effective date of this Ordinance.
2. Two members to be appointed for an initial term ending two years from the effective date of this Ordinance.
3. Two members to be appointed for an initial term ending three years from the effective date of this Ordinance.

Upon the expiration of the initial terms all subsequent terms shall be three years.

SECTION 3. This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the official City newspaper and shall take effect 61 days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum is held as provided in Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case, this Ordinance shall become effective if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

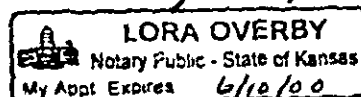
