CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 43

A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF SHAWNEE. KANSAS, FROM THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 13-1024a ENTITLED "GENERAL **IMPROVEMENTS** AND LANDS THEREFOR: BORROWING MONEY AND BOND ISSUES: WHEN ELECTION REQUIRED" AND PROVIDING FOR SUBSTITUTE AND ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS ON THE SAME SUBJECT: AND **REPEALING CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 35.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SHAWNEE, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. The City of Shawnee, Kansas (the "City"), by the power vested in it by Article XII, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, hereby exempts itself from and makes inapplicable to it the provisions of K.S.A. 13-1024a entitled "General Improvements and Lands Therefor; Borrowing Money and Bond Issues; When Election Required" a legislative enactment which is applicable to the City, but is not applicable uniformly to all cities in the State of Kansas; and the City hereby provides substitute and additional provisions on the same subject.

SECTION 2. The City may, for the purpose of paying for any street, trafficway, sidewalk, trail, storm water control, curbs, gutters, bridge, viaduct, public building, off street parking facility, public park, golf course, recreation facility or for the acquiring of land for any of the aforesaid purposes, either within or without the City, or for the purpose of acquiring, improving or extending electric or electronic traffic control system, fiber optic cable system, or the improvement, repair, extension of any water works, sewage disposal plants, storm sewer, drainage improvement or public utility, or for the purpose of rebuilding, repairing, adding to or extending the same from time to time as the necessity of the City may require, the City may borrow money and issue bonds therefore without such bonds having been authorized by vote of the public.

SECTION 3. The authority to issue bonds provided for by this Charter Ordinance is a complete alternative to and in addition to any other lawful method of or authority for the City to issue bonds. Any improvement or land acquisition previously authorized to be paid for by bonds issued pursuant to Charter Ordinance No. 35 may be paid for by bonds issued pursuant to this Charter Ordinance.

SECTION 4. Charter Ordinance No. 35, which previously exempted the City from K.S.A. 13-1024a, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in an official City newspaper.

SECTION 6. This Charter Ordinance shall take effect sixty-one (61) days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed as provided in Article XII, Section 5, Subdivision (c)(3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case this Charter Ordinance shall become effective only upon approval by a majority of electors voting at an election held on the Ordinance.

SECTION 7. Upon its effective date, this Charter Ordinance shall be recorded by the City Clerk in a book maintained for charter ordinances of the City and shall be filed with the Secretary of the State of Kansas.

SECTION 1. Any improvement or land acquisition previ ously authorized to be paid for by bonds issued pursuant to Charter Ordinance No. 35 may be paid for by bonds issued pursuant to this Charter Ordinance.

SECTION 4. Charter Ordinance No. 35, which previously exempted the City from K.S.A. 13 1024a, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in an official City newspaper.

SECTION 6. This Charter Ordinance shall take effect

SECTION 7. Upon its effective date, this Charter Ordinance shall be recorded by the City Clerk in a book maintained for charter or-dinances of the City and shall be filed with the Secretary of the State of Kan-
