## ORDINANCE NO. 356

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 258, WHICH ORDINANCE PROVIDES A UNIFORM PAY PLAN AND RELATED PERSONNEL PROCEUDRES FOR CITY EMPLOYEES AND OFFICERS, TO AMEND THE CLASSIFICATION SCHEDULE; AND TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 352 IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY PERTAINING THERETO.

The City Council of Boulder City do ordain:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 352 is hereby repealed in its entirety and Section 4 of Ordinance No. 258 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'SECTION 4. The following classifications are established and placed in the salary ranges as set forth above in Section 3:

Section 1, contd.

- ''A. The provisions of this Section notwithstanding, a department head, with the approval of the City Manager, may designate a 'Leadman' and such employee shall be paid a salary one (1) range higher, in the same step as his regular position, for as long as he acts in this capacity.
- "B. The provision of this Section notwithstanding, the Council, with the recommendation of the City Manager, may set classifications and salaries, by resolution, for special technical and professional positions which may be created."

SECTION 2. Validity. Each section and each provision or requirement of any section of this Ordinance shall be considered separable, and the invalidity of any portion shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other portion.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective the 9th day of March , 1970.

SECTION 4. Publication. The City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published on Thursday, the 5th day of February, 1970, in the Boulder City News, a weekly newspaper, published in Boulder City, Nevada.
