

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HAWAIIAN  
GARDENS AMENDING SECTION 5.32.060 OF  
THE HAWAIIAN GARDENS MUNICIPAL CODE  
TO ADD SUB-SECTION 27 THERETO RELATIVE  
TO HEALTH CLUBS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAWAIIAN GARDENS  
DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 5.32.060 of Chapter 5.32 of  
the Hawaiian Gardens Municipal Code is hereby  
amended by adding sub-section 27 thereto which  
shall read as follows:

27. Health Clubs.

A. For the purposes of this Chapter, "Health  
Clubs" shall be defined as any place which has therein  
a swimming pool, soaking facility such as a spa, tub  
or any other device in which a person can soak, a steamroom,  
a sauna or bathing place, including shower baths.

B. For the purposes of this Chapter, "Health Clubs"  
shall not include:

1. A private residence, condominium, townhouse,  
trailer park, or apartment complex;
2. A place where any treatment is administered  
in the course of the practice of any healing art or profession  
under the provisions of the Business and Professions Code  
or any other statute of the State of California; or
3. A place of employment where bathing facilities  
for the use of employees are required by law.

C. A permit shall not be issued pursuant to this Chapter  
unless an inspection reveals that the establishment complies  
with each of the following minimum requirements of this  
article:

1. Signs. A recognizable and readable sign shall  
be posted at the main entrance identifying the establishment.  
Such sign shall comply with all requirements of all city  
ordinances.

2. Cleanliness.

- (a) Hot and cold running water shall be  
provided at all times.

- (b) Separate closed cabinets shall be provided  
for the storage of clean and soiled towels, and shall be  
plainly marked: "Clean Towels" - "Soiled Towels".

D. Adequate bathing, dressing, locker, and toilet  
facilities shall be provided for patrons. A minimum of  
one dressing room, containing a separate locker for each

patron to be served, which locker shall be capable of being locked, as well as a minimum of one toilet and one washbasin shall be provided, provided, however that if male and female patrons are to be served simultaneously at the establishment, separate dressing and separate toilet facilities shall be provided for male and for female patrons.

E. Every establishment for which this article requires a license shall be maintained and operated in conformity with the following provisions:

1. All walls, ceilings, floors, pools, showers, bath-tubs, steamrooms, and all other physical facilities for the establishment shall be in good repair and maintained in a clean and sanitary condition.

2. Clean and sanitary towels shall be provided for each patron of the establishment. No common use of towels or linens shall be permitted.


3. Each permittee shall admit any duly authorized person for the purpose of making an inspection of the premises on behalf of the City of Hawaiian Gardens.

4. The operator of a Health Club shall procure and at all times maintain in full force and effect a policy of liability insurance for insuring him against liability arising from personal injury with limits of not less than \$300,000 for any one occurrence and \$100,000 for any one person per occurrence.


5. All equipment must be maintained in a good state of repair.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately as an urgency ordinance pursuant to Section 36937 of the Government Code. The facts constituting the urgency are that there are pending plans to open such types of businesses in the city and without adequate provisions for protection of the public, the public health, safety and welfare will be endangered by the possibility of inadequate safeguards.


