# **ORDINANCE NO. 561**

# AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OFHAWAIIAN GARDENS, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SECTION 5.92.400 OF THE HAWAIIAN GARDENS MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO CARD CLUB GAMING TABLES ALLOWED IN THE CITY.

The City Council of the City of Hawaiian Gardens does ordain as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>.Section 5.92.400 of Chapter 5.92 of Title 5of the Hawaiian Gardens Municipal Codeis hereby amended to read as follows (addition in **bold underline**):

5.92.400 Number of licensed tables allowed in city.

There shall be no more than six hundred licensed gaming tables in the city. The maximum number of gaming tables permitted in any one card club shall be three hundred **seventy-four**.

<u>SECTION2.</u> The Mayor or presiding officer of the City Council is hereby authorized to affix his/her signature to this Ordinance signifying its adoption by the City Council.

<u>SECTION3.</u> The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and cause the same to be posted at the duly designated posting places within the City and published once within fifteen (15) days after passage and adoption as required by law, or in the alternative, the City Clerk may cause to be published a summary of this Ordinance and a certified copy of the text of this Ordinance shall be posted in the Office of the City Clerk five (5) days prior to the date of adoption of this Ordinance, and, within fifteen (15) days after adoption, the City Clerk shall cause to be published the aforementioned summary and shall post a certified copy of this Ordinance, together with the vote for and against the same, in the Office of City Clerk.

#### **SUMMARY**
