

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND ADOPTING NEW ON-STREET PARKING TIME RESTRICTIONS ON THE EAST SIDE OF SWIFT BETWEEN 14<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE AND 15<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of North Kansas City, Missouri (the “City”) is a body corporate, a third class city and political subdivision of the State of Missouri, duly created, organized and validly existing under and by virtue of the Constitution and laws of the State of Missouri; and

**WHEREAS**, the City manages use of the right-of-way, including managing space used for on-street parking, to provide for the public health, safety, and convenience; and

**WHEREAS**, the City’s adopted Master Plan, approved by the City Council on May 17, 2016, and adopted by the Planning Commission on June 2, 2016, recommended that the City manage parking, loading, and operations in the public right-of-way to encourage safety, economic vitality, and livability; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires revise the existing on-street parking time restrictions on the east side of Swift Street between 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue in the City of North Kansas City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.**     **On-street Parking Regulations Established.** The City Council does hereby find and determine that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of North Kansas City, Missouri to modify, amend and update certain on-street parking time restrictions in the City. The City Council does, therefore, enact the following on-street parking time restrictions:

Parking on the east side of Swift Street, from 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue and extending north to 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue is restricted to 2 hour parking between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., excluding Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays. It shall be unlawful to park for more than two hours along the east side of Swift Street, beginning at 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue and extending north to 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue as herein described.

**Section 2.**     **Posting of Appropriate Signage.** The Director of Public Works is hereby directed to erect and install appropriate signage advising the public of the parking restrictions at the location described in Section 1 of this Ordinance.


**Section 3.**     **Providing for Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances.** All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, or any parts hereof, are hereby repealed. Where appropriate, ordinances previously adopted are hereby amended to conform to the provisions of this Ordinance.

**Section 4.** Severability. The sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance shall be severable. In the event that any such section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the remaining portions of this Ordinance are valid, unless the court finds the valid portions of this Ordinance are so essential to and inseparably connected with and dependent upon the void portion that it cannot be presumed that the City has enacted the valid portions without the void ones, or unless the court finds that the valid portions, standing alone, are incomplete and are incapable of being executed in accordance with the legislative intent.


**Section 5.** Governing Law. This Ordinance shall be governed exclusively by and construed in accordance with the applicable laws of the State of Missouri.

**Section 6.** Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect, after compliance with all governing laws, rules, and regulations, upon passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.


