

ORDINANCE NO. 2021- 21

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2.122 OF THE ALAMEDA COUNTY
ADMINISTRATIVE CODE REGARDING MEMBERSHIP OF THE
AGRICULTURAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Alameda ordains as follows:

SECTION I

Section 2.122.040 of the Alameda County Administrative Code is amended as follows:

In the first sentence, delete “eighteen (18)” and insert “nineteen (19)”.

In Subsection B, add the following paragraph after paragraph 8:

“9. Urban Agriculture. Must be a resident of Alameda County with expertise and either professional or scholastic involvement in urban-rural agroecosystems, urban agriculture or, peri-urban agriculture.”

SECTION II

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after the date of passage and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage it shall be published once with the names of the members voting for and against the same in the Inter-City Express, a newspaper published in the County of Alameda.
