ORDINANCE NO. 22-03-16

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 5.98, LOCAL VIDEO GAMING LICENSES OF TITLE 5, BUSINESS REGULATIONS AND LICENSES, OF THE VILLAGE OF MUNDELEIN MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, the Village of Mundelein is an Illinois municipal corporation (the "Village") with home rule authority and the adoption of this ordinance is being done through its home rule powers;

WHEREAS, Section 27 of the Video Gaming Act, 230 ILCS 40, authorizes the Village to prohibit video gaming within the corporate limits of the Village and implied within such authorization is the authority to limit, license and regulate video gaming within the corporate limits of the Village;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Mundelein, County of Lake, Illinois, that:

SECTION 1. Chapter 5.98, Local Video Gaming Licenses, Paragraph 5.98.020, Premises on which video gaming terminals are permitted of the Village of Mundelein Municipal Code shall be amended with the underline language being added and the stricken language being deleted, to read as follows:

5.98.020 - Premises on which video gaming terminals are permitted.

Video gaming terminals are only permitted on the following premises:

- (a) Licensed retail establishments in the Village of Mundelein where alcoholic liquor is drawn, poured, mixed, or otherwise served for consumption on the premises as permitted under the Act, the State Gaming Board Regulations and the rules and regulations contained in this chapter, and where no cash-dispensing terminal, as defined in 205 ILCS 616/1 et seq., is located in or on such premises; and
- (b) Licensed fraternal establishments and veteran establishments in the Village of Mundelein as permitted under the Act, the State Gaming Board Regulations and the rules and regulations contained in this chapter, in which no cash-dispensing terminal, as defined in 205 ILCS 616/1 et seq., is located in or on such premises.

SECTION II. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, invalidate, or nullify the remainder thereof, which remainder hall remain and continue in full force and effect.

SECTION III. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>SECTION IV.</u> This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and public in pamphlet form (which publication is hereby authorized) as provided by law.
