**ORDINANCE NO. 22-11-54**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5.76 OF THE MUNDELEIN MUNICIPAL CODE  
FOR CLASS B LIQUOR LICENSES  
AUTHORIZED IN THE VILLAGE OF MUNDELEIN  
AS IT RELATES TO 626 EAST HAWLEY STREET**

**WHEREAS**, Shrinidhi A2, Inc. owned by Bhumika Amin, purchased the business at 626 East Hawley Street from Three Patels, Inc. dba Mundelein Liquors and has been approved for a Class B liquor license for the premises; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mundelein Board of Trustees has determined that it is in the best interest of the Village to decrease the number of Class B liquor licenses from eighteen (18) to seventeen (17) due to the reduction of the Three Patels, Inc. license and then increase the number of Class B liquor licenses from seventeen (17) to eighteen (18) to permit the retail sale of alcohol at 626 E. Hawley Street by Shrinidhi A2, Inc. doing business as Mundelein Food and Liquor.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MUNDELEIN BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MUNDELEIN, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, that:**

**SECTION I.** Subsection B of Section 5.76.140, License classification; fees; number; hours; is hereby amended to and shall henceforth read as follows:

- B. Class B license, which shall authorize the retail sale on the licensed premises described of alcoholic liquor in their original packages, but not for consumption on the premises where sold. The annual fee for each such license shall be one thousand five hundred dollars. There shall be no more than a total of eighteen Class B licenses outstanding and in force at any one time. Sale of alcoholic liquor shall be prohibited from midnight through six a.m. The delivery shall be made only within 12 hours from the time the alcoholic liquor leaves the licensed premises of the retailer for delivery. For the purposes of this Section, "delivery" means the movement of alcoholic liquor purchased from a Class B licensed retailer to a consumer through the following methods:

- (1) delivery within licensed retailer's parking lot, including curbside, for pickup by the consumer;
- (2) delivery by an owner, officer, director, shareholder, or employee of the licensed retailer; or
- (3) delivery by a third-party contractor, independent contractor, or agent with whom the licensed retailer has contracted to make deliveries of alcoholic liquors.

Under subsection (1), (2), or (3), delivery shall not include the use of common carriers.

**SECTION II. Severability.** If any section, paragraph or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION III. Repeal of Prior Ordinances.** All prior Ordinances in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby expressly repealed only to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

**SECTION IV. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form, as required by law.
