

**ORDINANCE NO. 1, SERIES 2021**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 22-20 OF THE CITY OF NEWCASTLE, WYOMING MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING THE CREATION AND ESTABLISHMENT OF TREE ADVISORY BOARD AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, The Governing Body for the City of Newcastle, Wyoming has recommended the amendment of Ordinance No. 22-20 of the City of Newcastle Municipal Code as hereinafter set forth; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Newcastle held final reading of said proposed amended Ordinance 22-20 on April 19, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Newcastle publicly read proposed amended Ordinance 22-20 on three different days, pursuant to W.S. 15-1-115(c); and

WHEREAS, passage of the proposed Ordinance received the affirmative vote of the majority of the qualified members of the Governing Body of the City of Newcastle; and

WHEREAS, adoption of proposed amended Ordinance 22-20 as hereinafter set forth will recognize changing conditions in the City of Newcastle and is in harmony with the purpose of the City of Newcastle Municipal Code.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF NEWCASTLE, WESTON COUNTY, WYOMING that:**

Proposed Amended Ordinance No. 22-20 is hereby adopted by the Governing Body of the City of Newcastle, Wyoming and said Amended Ordinance 22-20 shall read as follows:

**Ordinance Section 22-20—Creation and Establishment of Tree Advisory Board**

There is created and established a tree advisory board for the city which will consist of no less than three nor more than ten volunteer members appointed by the governing body of the city. Any adult having a residence within five miles of the designated city limits of the City of Newcastle, Wyoming may be appointed. There shall be no terms of office, and members of the tree advisory board shall serve until such time as they resign or are removed for cause by the governing body of the city.


This Ordinance shall become effective after passage and upon publication as provided by law.


