

ORDINANCE NO. 27,978

**ORDINANCE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY:**

**SECTION 1.** That Chapter 60 of the Oklahoma City Municipal Code, 2020, is hereby amended by enacting Section 60-7 to read as follows:

**CHAPTER 60**

**GENERAL SCHEDULE OF FEES**

**§60-7. Legislative findings regarding the imposition of service fees on certain permits, licenses, and fees set forth in Chapter 60.**

- (a) For decades, the City has accepted payment by credit and debit cards for permit fees, license fees, and a variety of City services. The City incurs substantial processing fees when accepting payment by credit and debit cards. The City has historically subsidized these processing expenses from its General Fund. These fees are continually increasing. In fiscal year 2024-2025, the City incurred in excess of \$900,000 in processing and associated fees for accepting credit card and debit card payments.
- (b) The City has considered the feasibility of imposing a “Service Fee”, as authorized by 14A O.S. §2-211, upon those persons or entities making payment by credit or debit cards for certain permits, fees and licenses, in order to minimize loss to the City’s main operating fund – the General Fund.
- (c) The City defines a “Service Fee”, by credit card industry standards, as fees incurred by the City, such as processing and financial transaction fees incurred only by the acceptance of credit and debit card payment, which will hereafter be passed on to the purchaser who is making payment to the City via credit or debit cards, whether online or in-person. The Service Fees which may be recouped are limited as set forth in state law.
- (d) Software updates and other actions to enable this Service Fee to be charged by the City, will come at an additional cost to the City; therefore, the City will charge Service Fees only as set forth in this Chapter 60, on those certain permits, licenses, and fees which on average cost the City the most in processing and financial transaction fees.
- (e) The City shall post, clearly and conspicuously, a notice of the amount of the Service Fee at the point of entry and the point of sale for in-person transactions and on the home page and the point-of-sale webpage for online transactions. Such notice shall also be verbally disclosed to the customer for transactions processed over the phone.
- (f) No Service Fee shall be imposed by the City if the only acceptable payment method for the certain permit, license, or fee is via credit or debit cards.
- (g) Service Fees are not being charged as a revenue stream for the City but merely to recoup the actual processing costs the City incurs for accepting credit and debit card payments.

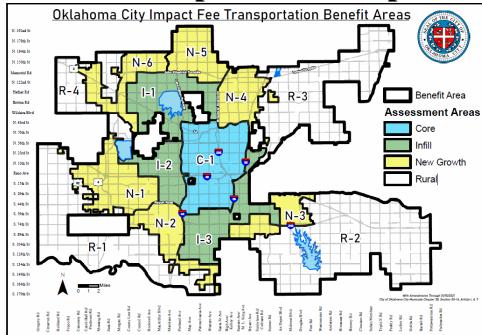

will be designated an assessment area category and a service area / benefit area as established on the Streets Development Fee Map.

The Streets Development Fee Map will be deemed revised by virtue of the approval of the revised Comprehensive Plan by City Council.
