

ORDINANCE NO. 2159

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-60-060 OF THE BROOMFIELD MUNICIPAL CODE REMOVING THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR THE CHIEF OF POLICE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF BROOMFIELD, COLORADO:

Section 1. Section 2-60-060 of the Broomfield Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

2-60-060 - Police department.

~~(A)~~ There is hereby established a police department, which shall be supervised by a police chief. The police department includes all municipal police functions and all county sheriff functions, including but not limited to court security, jail management, ~~emergency management~~, and civil process.


~~(B) The police chief shall be a resident of the City and County of Broomfield no later than nine months following the commencement date of appointment to the position and throughout tenure as police chief thereafter.~~

Section 2. This ordinance shall be effective seven days after publication following final passage.
